

MEDICAL TOURIST (C-3-3)

A person who is visiting Korea for medical treatment or recuperation at a medical institution and patient's a family member immediate family as caregiver.

Medical visa type (Entry/Validity)

- Single-entry visa (maximum duration of stay 90 days): Short-term visa single-entry/ valid for 3 months Double-entry visa/ valid for 6 months
- Medical visa more than 91 days: G-1-10 (Short-term visa multi-entry/valid for 1 year/Visa fee 60\$)

The Korean Diplomatic mission can ask for additional documents.

1. A patient who visited already twice Korea with a Medical Tourism Visa (C-3-3)

COMMON DOCUMENTS
1. Visa Application Form (Form no. 17), one 3.5X4.5 cm picture taken in the past 6 months
2. Passport in original and a copy
3. Copy of the previous C-3-3 visa and the copy of immigration stamps
4. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)
5. Previous records of medical treatment in Korea; Specification in the confirmation of appointment for treatment of returning patient or routine examination
6. Proof of Financial means

Invitation from a Korean hospital, Confirmation of the appointment with the doctor in a Korean hospital, Copy of the business registration certificate of the Korean hospital, Proof of registration of the hospital in Korea as certified institute for foreign patient treatments.

2. A patient who has paid already at least KWN 10,000,000 of the medical treatment:

COMMON DOCUMENTS
1. Visa Application Form (Form no. 17), one 3.5X4.5 cm picture taken in the past 6 months
2. Passport in original and a copy
3. Invoice of the pre-paid payment (remittance, bank statement, card slip) stating the name of the remitter and the payee * Can be stated on the name of patient's direct family
4. A certificate issued by one of the authorized hospitals in Mongolia
5. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)

Invitation from a Korean hospital, Confirmation of the appointment with the doctor in a Korean hospital, Copy of the business registration certificate of the Korean hospital, Proof of registration of the hospital in Korea as certified institute for foreign patient treatments.

Authorized hospitals: National Traumatology and Orthopedic Research Centre, National Cancer Centre, General Hospital 1, 2, and 3

3. A patient who is going to have surgery in Korea

COMMON DOCUMENTS

2.	Passport in original and a copy
3.	A certificate issued by one of the authorized hospitals in Mongolia A confirmation of the appointment for the surgery from the Korean institution
4.	Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)
5.	Proof of Financial means

Invitation from a Korean hospital, Confirmation of the appointment with the doctor in a Korean hospital, Copy of the business registration certificate of the Korean hospital, Proof of registration of the hospital in Korea as certified institute for foreign patient treatments.

Authorized hospitals: National Traumatology and Orthopedic Research Centre, National Cancer Centre, General Hospital 1, 2, and 3

4. A critical patient with acute disease and the immediate family member as caregiver

4.	A certificate issued by one of the authorized hospitals in Mongolia

Business owner:	
• Tax payment certificate (at least MNT 500,000 for 6 months)	
Employee:	
• Copy of social insurance book;	
• Confirmation of payment of social insurance (monthly base salary of at least MNT 500,000 for the past 6 months)	
Other cases:	
• Bank statement on the name of the applicant for the past 6 months*	
*Joint accounts cannot be accepted	

Invitation from a Korean hospital, Confirmation of the appointment with the doctor in a Korean hospital, Copy of the business registration certificate of the Korean hospital, Proof of registration of the hospital in Korea as certified institute for foreign patient treatments.

Authorized hospitals: National Traumatology and Orthopedic Research Centre, National Cancer Centre, General Hospital 1, 2, and 3

An immediate family member as caregiver:

1. Visa Application Form (Form no. 17), one 3.5X4.5 cm picture taken in the past 6 months
 2. Passport in original and a copy
 3. Invitation from a Korean hospital
 4. Proof of financial means
 5. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)
 6. Family relation certificate (issued within the last 45 days)
- *If the caregiver is not accompanied by the patient, it is not eligible for medical visa.

5. A retired old aged patient

COMMON DOCUMENTS

1. Visa Application Form (Form no. 17), one 3.5X4.5 cm picture taken in the past 6 months
2. Passport in original and a copy
3. Retirement book copy
4. A certificate issued by one of the authorized hospitals in Mongolia
5. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)
6. Proof of financial means

Invitation from a Korean hospital, Confirmation of the appointment with the doctor in a Korean hospital, Copy of the business registration certificate of the Korean hospital, Proof of registration of the hospital in Korea as certified institute for foreign patient treatments.

Authorized hospitals: National Traumatology and Orthopedic Research Centre, National Cancer Centre, General Hospital 1, 2, and 3

6. A patient who had a surgery in the past 2 years in Korea:

COMMON DOCUMENTS

1. Visa Application Form (Form no. 17), one 3.5X4.5 cm picture taken in the past 6 months
2. Passport in original and a copy
3. Previous records of medical treatment in Korea;
Specification in the confirmation of appointment for treatment of returning patient or routine examination
4. Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)
5. Proof of financial means

Invitation from a Korean hospital, Confirmation of the appointment with the doctor in a Korean hospital, Copy of the business registration certificate of the Korean hospital, Proof of registration of the hospital in Korea as certified institute for foreign patient treatments.

Authorized hospitals: National Traumatology and Orthopedic Research Centre, National Cancer Centre, General Hospital 1, 2, and 3

7. A patient who will undergo a surgery in Korea sponsored by a charity organization in Korea and the immediate family member as caregiver:

COMMON DOCUMENTS	
1.	Visa Application Form (Form no. 17), one 3.5X4.5 cm picture taken in the past 6 months
2.	Passport in original and a copy
3.	Official invitation letter issued by the charity organization
4.	A certificate issued by one of the authorized hospitals in Mongolia
5.	Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)
6.	Proof of financial means

Invitation from a Korean hospital, Confirmation of the appointment with the doctor in a Korean hospital, Copy of the business registration certificate of the Korean hospital, Proof of registration of the hospital in Korea as certified institute for foreign patient treatments.

Authorized hospitals: National Traumatology and Orthopedic Research Centre, National Cancer Centre, General Hospital 1, 2, and 3

An immediate family member as caregiver:	
1.	Visa Application Form (Form no. 17), one 3.5X4.5 cm picture taken in the past 6 months
2.	Passport in original and a copy
3.	Invitation from a Korean hospital
4.	Proof of financial means
5.	Marriage certificate (issued within the last 45 days)
6.	Family relation certificate (issued within the last 45 days) *If the caregiver is not accompanied by the patient, it is not eligible for medical visa.

In case of organ transplantation or artificial modification, according to Article 18(2) of the Mongolian Act on Organ Donation:

1. Family relation reference between donor and patient (issued within the last 45 days)
2. A medical certificate and a Korean hospital report on the need for organ transplantation
3. Certificate issued by the Mongolian Health Promotion Center's cell and organ transplant operation coordination office (in the case of liver, kidney, heart, lung, pancreas, small intestine, and artificial insemination).

Must attached an invitation issued by a medical institution.

Must submit a test of tuberculosis if a foreign tuberculosis patient in Korea invites his family to take care of his/her

If the caregiver is not accompanied by the patient, it is not eligible for medical visa.

Additional documents may be requested during the checking process.

The applicant may submit additional documents proving or guaranteeing the purpose of his/her treatment and the purpose of the caregiver's visit.
