* #1 (Exempted from International Marriage Information Program)

1. A person who can prove the fact that a foreign spouse has been dating while staying on a long-term visa for studying abroad or dispatched work for at least six months in a third country.
2. A person who can prove that a foreign spouse registered as a foreigner in Korea and stayed in Korea legally for more than 91 days while dating a Korean spouse.
3. A person who is deemed to need to be pregnant (more than 20 weeks), childbirth, and other humanitarian considerations;

* #2 (related to the Korean spouse's health certificate) It shall be issued in the form of a health examination table for public officials at a hospital level or a public health center, and within six months from the date of application. If you are exempt from the International Wedding Information Program, you will be exempted from submission.

* #3 If a Korean spouse (related to a foreign spouse's criminal record) is exempt from the International Marriage Information Program, submission will be exempted.

* #4 It is issued within 6 months from the date of application for a foreign spouse's health certificate. The hospital name, address, contact number, and doctor's signature must be written and written on the computer (in unavoidable cases, by hand). In addition to the examination items included in the example of health examination items, the examination items for TB, mental illness, AIDS, and STD should also be included. Only medical certificates issued by each Imak General Hospital or similar large hospitals are accepted. If a Korean spouse is exempt from the international marriage information program, a foreign spouse will be exempted from submitting a health certificate, but a certificate related to tuberculosis should be submitted. (If it is difficult to diagnose tuberculosis due to pregnancy, please contact us separately.)

2. Korean spouse's income requirements documents

* **Caution:** You do not need to prepare all the documents below for income requirements (provided, documents for «common essential» items) and selectively prepare them according to the items that invitees use to meet income requirements.

* **Those exempt from income requirements do not need to submit the following documents: (See #1 below)**

* #1 (Exempt from income requirements) If a couple has a child born or more than 20 weeks pregnant. If a couple has lived abroad for more than one year from the date of visa application and has no domestic income for the past year. If a foreign spouse has been in Korea (F-6). Provided, That if a person falls under , he/she shall submit a family relationship certificate (birth certificate if he/she is born before marriage and acquisition of nationality) or a pregnancy certificate , he/she shall submit a document related to cohabitation.

* #2 (Precautions on business income 1) Business income is determined based on the amount stated in the National Tax Service's income certificate in principle. If the actual income is greater than the amount in the proof of income amount, it may be equivalent to underreporting the income, so please submit the revised income amount proof after reporting it to the tax office.

* #3 (Precautions on Business Income 2) In principle, data on income should be submitted one year prior to the date of application, but business income is characterized by income reporting in May of the following year. In consideration of this, if the income of the most recent year on the certificate of income meets the set income requirements and the Korean spouse continues the same business, exceptions are accepted even if they are not one year prior to the application date.

* #4 (range of family members who can supplement income requirements) Only immediate family members (parents, grandparents, children, etc.) or marriage immigrants who share the income requirements with Korean spouses on the resident registration table can supplement income requirements. Even if you are a direct family, you cannot supplement your income requirements unless you share a generation on the resident registration table, and you cannot supplement your income requirements because brothers or sisters are not immediate family members.

* (Note) 2021 Income Requirements: Invitees' annual income (before tax) for the past year must be at least the amount corresponding to the table below

* #1 (Exempt from communication requirements) If there are children born between couples or more than 20 weeks pregnant; If a foreign spouse has stayed in Korea as a marriage immigrant (F-6), the communication documents will be exempted.

* #2 (Other communication verification documents) If a Korean spouse or a foreign spouse submits a certain level of proficiency test scores, he/she may be recognized as having met communication requirements if he/she passes an interview conducted in the relevant language.

In principle, if it is owned or leased under the name of a third party, it is judged that it does not meet the housing requirements.

[Precautions]

1. The above list of required documents is on January 4, 2021. It was written on the basis of. Due to changes in visa screening criteria, changes may be made without prior notice. Please check the list of required documents on the embassy website before applying for a visa.

2. If the required documents are omitted, visa application may be rejected, so please refer to the list of required documents to prepare. In order to receive documents quickly, please submit them in order of number. For reference, the list of required documents is the basic documents that must be submitted when applying for a marriage immigrant visa. Additional documents may be requested if deemed necessary during the visa application process or visa screening process.

3. For the application of documents, the visa applicant (spouse of a foreigner) must visit the Korea Visa Application Center (KVAC) and apply by mail, and mail submissions are not permitted. Documents are accepted from 08:30 am to 16:30 am.

4. The visa screening period is 20 working days, but may be delayed due to reasons such as document inquiry period, request for additional documents, interview, and survey. For visa issuance, in the case of normal examination period, the visa is issued on the scheduled date of issuance. Please note that even if a visa is issued, separate procedures may be required for departure depending on the country. For reference, wedding visa holders can issue one-way air tickets.

5. In the case of a false statement or submission of false documents when applying for a visa, the visa application may be rejected and the foreign spouse may be prohibited from entering Korea for more than 5 years, and this fact was discovered after the foreign spouse entered Korea. If you do, you may be forcibly eviction. In addition, in accordance with Article 7-2 of the Immigration Control Act and Article 94 of the same Act, you may be subject to imprisonment for up to three years or a fine of up to 20 million won.

6. In principle, all documents must be submitted in the original, and translations other than English and Korean must be submitted. (However, notarization will be requested individually later if necessary at the embassy.)

7. If you first marry in the foreign spouse's country, please check whether the marriage date on the foreign spouse's marriage certificate is the same as the marriage notification date on the Korean marriage relationship certificate. Please note that there are often cases where the date when a Korean spouse does not stay in the country is listed as the date of marriage due to administrative issues in each country.
